Remote Learning: KS2 Code of Conduct

- I will always try my best and do my best work.
- I will not log into Teams unless invited by my teacher.
- I will tell a trusted adult if I see or hear anything that worries me when I am working online or on my device.
- I will only use Microsoft Teams as directed by my teacher and will only upload material that is related to my learning into my named folder(s) on Teams.
- I understand that **my Mum or Dad** is responsible for my Teams email and login details.
- I will not use my Teams login details to communicate with anyone other than my class teacher and **ONLY** when directed to do so by my teacher during live sessions.
- I will not use my Teams email to create groups, initiate calls or initiate meetings and will end Teams sessions when my teacher tells me to do so.
- During any live sessions, my Mum or Dad must be present in the room or in the next room with the door open so they can see and hear everything that is happening during the live session.
- I will not take photos of my screen or record online interactions in any way.
- I will make sure that my communication in the online learning environment (Purple Mash and Teams) is always supportive of my learning and the learning and wellbeing of others.
- I will complete work set after the class teacher has taught me.
- If I do not keep to the rules then I know that there will be sanctions - For example B-Logs will be issued, my Mum or Dad will be informed and KS2 detention on my return to school.
