Homework One - Key words. LEARN your key words, you will be tested in class.

Kutub – The groups of **books** Muslims believe that Allah revealed to other prophets who came before Muhammad (PBUH).

Scrolls of Abraham – The Scrolls were an **early scripture** that are now **lost**. It taught Muslims what Allah revealed to the Prophet Ibrahim

Torah –The Torah is the Jewish holy book, which was revealed to **Moses** .It contains the **Ten Commandments**.

Gospel- This is a book believed to have been given to Isa (Jesus). The meaning of this book has been changed over time.

Psalms – This is the book given to Dawud (King David). They are mentioned in the Qur'an & the Bible.

Homework Two - Key words

Tawhid – The belief in the oneness of Allah.

Shahadah– Declaration of faith.

This is the first and most important pillar for all Muslims.

Sawm – This pillar describes fasting. Muslims will fast for 40 days during Ramadan.

Salah –This describes the Pillar of Prayer. Muslims believe prayer is one of the main ways to communicate with Allah.

Zakah – Zakah is the practice where a Muslim gives 2.5% of their total income to charity.

Hajj – This describes the pilgrimage which all Muslims are expected to do at least once in their life.

Jummah – Friday prayers, usually held in the mosque.
