Week One - Key words **Learn your key words, you will be tested in class.**

Civil war – A war that occurs in the same country.

Conflict – A serious disagreement or between countries.

Conscientious objector – A person who does not agree with war and will not fight due to religious reasons.

War – Two or more countries involved in a war.

Forgiveness – Giving someone a second chance.

Holy war (Lesser Jihad) – Rules around fighting a war acceptable to Islam.

Justice – Making things fair again.

Peace – The opposite of war e.g. Harmony.

Violence – Causing harm to someone.

Just war – Seven key rules which some Christians believe if followed can justify a war.

Nuclear weapons – A weapon used to cause mass destruction.

Pacifism – The belief that all violence is wrong.. Jesus was a pacifist.

Protest – Voicing disagreement with something.

Reconciliation – Becoming friendly again/making up between two groups after disagreement

Retaliation – To pay back for harmful action.

Terrorism – Use of violence and threat to create fear.

Weapons of mass destruction – (WMD's) Weapons which cause uncontrollable damage.
