### **Homework One**

**Omnipotent** – The idea that God is all-powerful.

**Omniscient** – The idea that God is all-seeing.

**Omnibenevolent** – The idea that God is all-loving.

**Just** – The idea that God is fair and will judge on the Day of Judgement.

**Monotheistic** – Christians believe in one God.

**Moral evil** is a term given to suffering inflicted by people on each other. For example – Murder.

**Trinity** – Christians believe that the God is one, but exists in three different persons. It includes God the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit.

**Homework Three –**

**Literal Christians** – Christians who believe the creation story as being factual.

**Liberal Christians** – Christians who do not take the creation story literally. They do believe God created the world.

**Incarnation** – The idea that Jesus is both human and son of God.

**Crucifixion** – The Roman method used to kill Jesus.

**Resurrection** – Jesus came back to life three days after his death.

**Ascension** – Jesus went back to heaven 40 days after his resurrection.
