<b>BLAZER</b>	Navy blue with badge
<b>TIES</b>	Navy blue ties with school logo and 3 single stripes in house colours
<b>FOOTWEAR</b>	Plain BLACK shoes appropriate for school use. Black trainers are not acceptable.
<b>TROUSERS</b>	Black school trousers
<b>SHIRT</b>	Plain white
<b>PULLOVER</b>	Navy blue V-necked pullover with School logo. (Optional)
<b>CARDIGAN</b>	Navy blue with School logo (Optional)
<b>SKIRT</b>	Navy skirt with red piping and box pleats (Knee Length)
<b>SOCKS</b>	Plain black
<b>TIGHTS</b>	Plain black
<b>COAT</b>	Dark coloured school coat

ALL GARMENTS AND POSSESSIONS BROUGHT TO SCHOOL MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED WITH THE PUPIL'S NAME.

<b>BLAZER</b>	Navy blue with badge. This garment should be worn at all times by both boys and girls.
<b>TIES</b>	Navy blue ties with school logo and 3 single stripes in House Colours
<b>TROUSERS</b>	Black school trousers, NO cotton casual jeans.
<b>SKIRT</b>	Navy Skirt with red piping and box pleats ONLY available from The Schoolwear Centre, Margate.
<b>SHIRT</b>	Plain WHITE only.
<b>PULLOVER</b>	Navy blue V-necked pullover with School logo for Years 7 - 11, (Optional)
<b>CARDIGAN</b>	Navy blue with School logo (Optional)
<b>SOCKS</b>	Plain black or white
<b>TIGHTS</b>	Plain black tights.
<b>COAT</b>	Navy blue shower proof coat with school logo (optional but preferred)
<b>SCARF</b>	Red fleece scarf with navy blue school logo
<b>FOOTWEAR</b>	Plain BLACK shoes, (NO OTHER COLOUR) appropriate for school use. No boots/ankle boots/sports trainers)

## SECONDARY PE KIT

<b>SHOES</b>	Non marking trainers with laces. Football Boots
<b>CLOTHING</b>	Navy blue with red side panel and school logo sport shirt reversible with house colour Navy shorts with red side panel Navy with red side panel skirt Navy and red reversible rugby jersey Navy with red side panel fleece with school logo (Optional) Football socks, with navy blue and white hoops. Navy School tracksuit bottoms with school logo may be worn over PE kits in winter months (Optional) Navy leggings with school logo may be worn over PE kits in the winter months (Optional)
<b>ACCESSORIES</b>	Shin pads, Gum shield BAGA bag for PE clothes is optional.
<b>SHOWERS</b>	Individual showers are available. A towel will be required.

**For hygienic reasons these articles of clothing should be taken home and washed each week.**

### SECONDARY PHYSICAL EDUCATION EXPECTATIONS

Procedure if your child is unable to participate in their PE lesson:

- 1) If your child is ill or injured they must bring a note in from home.
- 2) If your child is unable to participate due to a long term medical condition a medical certificate must be provided. This should be updated termly.
- 3) When your child is ill or injured, they must bring in their PE kit and get changed. They then will be involved within the lesson completing worksheets, officiating and carrying out peer assessments.

Procedure if a child does not bring in kit for the lesson:

- 1) If your child forgets their kit, staff will provide the student with school kit. If they refuse to wear this kit they will be given a St George's afterschool detention.
- 2) If they then do not engage in the lesson, behaviour support will be contacted if your child fails to follow these procedures and then they will be removed to the safe room.

## SIXTH FORM - DRESS CODE EXPECTATIONS

### DRESS CODE:

Dress code as follows:

- All pupils must ensure their personal appearance is appropriate to the school setting.
- Boys should wear dark smart trousers with a shirt and tie.
- Girls should wear smart dresses or trousers/skirts with a top.
- Skirts and dresses must be a reasonable length, no shorter than just above the knee.
- Black lanyard

The following items **MUST NOT** be worn at any time:

- No vest tops
- No denim of any kind or colour
- No trainers
- No facial piercings
- No hoodies
- No leggings/jeggings

**ALL PUPILS MUST ABIDE BY THE UNIFORM RULES. ANY PUPIL NOT WEARING FULL UNIFORM WILL NOT BE ALLOWED INTO NORMAL LESSONS. THE FOLLOWING RULES MUST BE ADHERED TO:**

**Hair:**

Hair should be in a style acceptable to the school and of a natural colour. Hair must be no shorter than a grade 2 cut and there must be no patterns shaved into the head. If, in the opinion of the Headteacher, hair is unacceptable parents will be informed and the child may be isolated or sent home. Parents are advised to contact the School prior to visiting a hairdresser if they have any queries regarding acceptable hairstyles.

**Make Up:**

Make-up must NOT be worn in school. This included false eyelashes. Please ensure that your child is not bringing make-up into school. No fake or coloured nails are allowed in school.

**Jewellery:**

Pupils are only allowed ONE pair of small plain studs or ONE pair of plain sleepers – NO OTHER JEWELLERY IS PERMITTED. If a pupil wears a ring or other jewellery it will be confiscated, pupils can then collect at the end of the day.  
NO BODY STUDS ARE ALLOWED, INCLUDING NOSE AND TONGUE STUDS.
